- Submit a <u>scale</u> color design of vertical banner on 6" wide x 12" long paper
- Include a non-refundable entry fee of:
 - \$20 Adult Division (covers two banner designs)
 - \$15 Teen Division (covers two banner designs)
- Make check payable to: Plymouth Arts Council
- Entry deadline is Thursday, February 26, 2015, 4 p.m. (submissions will not be returned)
- If design(s) is selected as one of the top three in your division, artist will provide paints/materials to apply design(s)on one side of a 2' x 4' paper banner(s) which is provided by PAC
- Completed banner(s) must be delivered to the Parks & Recreation Department at the City Hall by
 Wednesday, April 15, 2015, 4 p.m.
