Seasonal Weight Restrictions

Spring restrictions in Plymouth are 5 tons per axle and apply to all city streets

- The City of Plymouth follows the seasonal weight restrictions dates determined by the MN Department of Transportation. The dates are posted each year on their website at: http://dotapp7.dot.state.mn.us/research/seasonal_load_limits/sllindex.asp
- Dates are in effect until MnDOT removes the spring load restrictions (max of 60 days).
- Exempt vehicles include School Buses, Garbage Trucks and Milk Trucks.
- Permits are rarely issued and are for emergency circumstances only. Contact Engineering at 763-509-5500 for information.
- Exemptions will not be given for paved roads: Troy Lane South of 56th Avenue (5 tons per axle year round).
- All city streets have a weight restriction of 7 tons per axle the rest of the year, unless posted (Troy Lane and private streets).
