METEOR CHERRY

A genetic dwarf introduced by the University of Minnesota, 1952. Blooms in May. This hybrid of Montmorency, bears bright red, medium-sized cherries in early to midsummer. Their tart/sweet yellow flesh is great for sauces, wonderful for pies, and good for fresh eating if fully ripe. Quick to come into fruiting, usually producing fruit the second year after planting. Ripens in mid-July. Requires a well drained soil. Height: 10' - 14'. A good choice for colder areas. Growing zones 4 to 8. Hardy to -30°
