- · All trips are chaperoned by adults
- Helmets are strongly recommended

TRIP REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is required for all trips.

Online: Begins Thur, Dec. 14, 2017 at 8:00 a.m.

In-Person/Phone-In: Begins Thurs, Dec. 14, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. Mail-In: Begins Thurs, Dec. 14, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. Mail to: Plymouth Parks & Rec, 3400 Plymouth Blvd, Plymouth, MN 55447.

- Registration must be received at the Parks & Recreation office by 4:30 pm on the Tuesday prior to that Friday's trip.
- · A receipt will be emailed as confirmation.
- · If a trip is full, you will be notified and placed on a waitlist.
- · Registered participants MUST ride the bus to & from the ski area.
- Each trip is \$60 per student. An additional \$22 will be added if ski/snowboard rental is required.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- If there is insufficient enrollment, the decision will be made on the Wednesday prior to the trip.
- Weather decisions are made on Friday at 10:00am based upon the forecast for the trip location and on transportation considerations, utilizing the National Weather Service and the Weather Channel. If the wind-chill is 15 degrees below zero the trip will be cancelled.
- If a trip is cancelled, a notice will be posted after 10:30 am on the Parks & Recreation weather line 763-509-5205.
- Announcements will be made at school in accordance with their policies.
- Full refunds will be issued if the trip is cancelled by Parks & Recreation. If a trip is cancelled, you may transfer to another trip (provided any trips remain) but you must request the transfer by calling 763-509-5200. Transfers are not automatic.

TRANSFER & WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- Transfers and withdrawals are available and must be requested at least 7 days prior to trip.
- Exceptions are made for serious illness/injury (Doctor's note would be required).
- · A \$10 service fee is retained on each withdrawal request.

SPECIAL NEEDS

Please note any special needs (ex. ADHD, asthma, hearing impaired, medication, etc.) when registering and inclusion needs can be reviewed.

RENTAL

Ski and Snowboard equipment rentals are available, please add \$22 to the registration fee for each trip.

Helmets are strongly recommended and available to rent at each ski area. Helmet fees are as follows:

- \$7 for Afton Alps
- \$8 for Powder Ridge
- Helmet is included with Ski/snowboard rental at Trollhaugen, fee is \$3 for helmet rental only

LESSONS ARE REQUIRED FOR BEGINNERS

All first time beginner skiers and snowboarders are required to take a lesson with the ski area on their **first trip** with the club.

EQUIPMENT STORAGE

Ski or snowboard bags are required to protect your equipment during transit. **Boldly label & ID your bag.**

A locked storage area for equipment will be available for students at their respective schools. Equipment must be dropped off and stored **before the start of the school day on Friday**. Below are the storage locations for each school.

- · WEMS: Room by pool/gym entrance, Lower Level.
- · WCMS: Lower Level C Book Room
- · **WWMS:** Lower Level by Industrial Tech.

STOLEN, DAMAGED OR LOST GEAR

The Ski & Snowboard Club is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items. You are responsible for your equipment. Use the coral.

- Make use of the ski and board coral at the areas we visit. All locations charge at least a \$1 fee for all evening protection.
- · On the bus, be mindful of your belongings.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Please indicate a home and cell number for parent/guardian and an alternate emergency contact other than the parent. In the event of an injury, the area ski patrol will provide immediate first aid and the ski area's emergency procedures will be followed. Chaperone/ski patrol will contact parent/emergency contact. Parent is responsible for student once transported by emergency management. If the injury is not severe, a parent/guardian may pick up the child at the ski area prior to bus departure, or the student may be transported on the bus.

BUS DEPARTURE

Meet at the club storage area. The bus and trailer will be loaded as soon as the school route buses leave.

BUS RETURN

Students must ride the bus home. The bus will return by 11:15 pm. A late pick-up fee of \$10 will be assessed, plus an additional \$5 for every 15 minutes you are late for pick-up. Program registration will be denied after the 2nd late pick-up. *The late fee must be paid before participation in the next trip.* **The school will be locked when we return, so transportation must be pre-arranged.** For their own safety, teens are not allowed to walk home after trips.

VOLUNTEER CHAPERONES

Adult volunteer chaperones are needed. Enjoy the slopes or stay warm in the chalet. Chaperones receive free lift ticket and rental. Note: trips may be cancelled if there is insufficient chaperone coverage. If interested, contact Parks & Recreation at recreation@plymouthmn.gov.

AT THE HILL

- Upon arrival, announcements will be made by trip advisors and chaperones - ask questions if you did not hear the announcements.
- It is your responsibility to know when the bus leaves for home a time for loading will always be announced. Individuals who return late from the slopes may have their membership suspended for a trip. Chronic tardiness will lead to membership termination.
- · Memorize the bus loading time and bus number.
- Please note that all members will remain on the bus while club leaders collect lift tickets and rental forms, and unload our equipment. Lift tickets will be distributed to you on the bus.
- Lessons start soon after arrival. If you registered for lessons you MUST attend the lesson.
- If you bring your own snowboard, leashes are mandatory at the ski areas to ride the lift.
- Helmets are strongly recommended and are available for rent at the ski area. Students must pay at the rental area.
