The Wayzata Youth Hockey Association will be hosting 40 high school teams from around the country for a national championship tournament at the Plymouth Ice Center. We anticipate that around 1,500 people will be attending the games.

Volunteers must be 16 years or older to participate. Once you have finished volunteering, you are welcome to stay to watch the games for free.

City of Plymouth volunteers will have two specific roles to help ensure this major event is a success:

Ticket Takers/Wristband Checkers will be responsible for taking tickets, stamping hands and checking wristbands for entry into the Ice Center at two different locations. Since you will be standing by entry doors, you will want to dress appropriately for the weather. At the beginning of the event, you will work as a pair; later in the event, there will be just one volunteer per entrance.

Ambassadors will provide a warm and friendly welcome to our visitors, answering general questions about the Ice Center and provide tourist information about where to go nearby to eat, shop, spend down time, etc. One volunteer will be stationed at the main upper level office and one will be stationed at the lower level office. We will have some promotional materials available with lists and maps of area restaurants and amenities, but feel free to be the local “expert” and tell our guests about your favorite spots. Volunteers in the lower level office will also radio maintenance workers to sharpen skates and provide pro shop sales when needed.
