






Which best describes how frequently you use County Road 47?



Going northbound on Vicksburg and taking a left on 47 is narrow. Make the shoulder on 47 wider.


I probably use this road once a year, I'm probably not the best to answer this.


Access to 494 to alleviate the incredible congestion that is increasing on Hwy 55. This is imperative.

After looking up the road, I know which road this is and I haven't driven on it for at least 3 years. What I remember about it, is that it seemed to have too high a speed limit for how curvy it was with residential areas. But again, I haven't driven on it in a while so I don't have an up-to-date perspective.

There is virtually no ability to walk on County Road 47 - with the amount of residential development in the area, it is vital that pedestrian access is provided on this road.

Dedicated turn lanes are needed. Please think through traffic flow turning north onto Vinewood from the west- many people cross multiple lanes of traffic coming from 494 or looping around people turning north onto 494.
