

ADOPT A PARK

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Help keep city parks and trails clean. This volunteer position is available through Plymouth Parks & Forestry.

TIME COMMITMENT:

- Once every 1-2 weeks year round.
- Once every 1-2 weeks during Spring-Fall (warmer weather months).
- One-time only for a person or group who wants to volunteer but cannot commit to entire summer.

ACTIVITIES/DUTIES:

- Pick up litter at the park or trail; free bags are available at the Maintenance Facility, 14900 23rd Avenue N
- Put litter in trash receptacles or if receptacle is full please place trash bags next to it. City garbage crew makes routine visits to all parks to remove trash.
- Keep sign planters weeded.
- Keep play structure area weeded.
- Be an additional pair of eyes at the park; report any damage, repair needs, potential dangers, or large items such as downed tree limbs at plymouthmn.gov/myPlymouth or by using the myPlymouth app, which is available from the Google Play and Apple app stores.
- Turn in a completed time sheet at the end of the season or enter hours online through the City's website. Instructions will be provided.

QUALIFICATIONS/DESIRED SKILLS:

- Enjoy being outdoors.
- Desire to keep City parks and trails clean and safe.
- Willing to follow through on a commitment.
- Dependable and responsible.
