

# ADOPT A STORM DRAIN

## VOLUNTEER POSITION

Help keep storm drains clear of leaves, yard waste and trash to prevent storm water pollution. This volunteer position is available through the Plymouth Public Works department.

### TIME COMMITMENT:

- As needed during spring and fall; year round if possible.

### ACTIVITIES/DUTIES:

- Remove leaves, twigs, yard waste and trash from storm drain grates and dispose appropriately.
- Keep storm drain free of ice and snow, if possible.
- Register your storm drain with the Adopt a Spot program so your storm drain and volunteer commitment can be recorded.
- Report any concerns as needed at [plymouthmn.gov/myPlymouth](http://plymouthmn.gov/myPlymouth) or by using the myPlymouth app, which is available from the Google Play and Apple app stores.

### QUALIFICATIONS/DESIRED SKILLS:

- Desire to keep Plymouth's watersheds free of storm water pollution.
- Willing to follow through on a commitment.
- Dependable and responsible.
- You can take your responsibilities a step further and check out a storm drain marking kit to apply a sticker educating others about storm drain pollution.

*Note: This is an unsupervised position but can be a great introduction for children to begin volunteering and learning about giving back to their communities.*
