FELIX SUPREME PEONY DESCRIPTION

A boldly alluring and prolific bloomer, year after year.
Large and showy, these deep ruby-red double flowers grow vigorously on tall, thick stems, which may need support in the garden. Blooms are complemented by dark green foliage and ideal for cutting. Lightly fragrant, Felix Supreme is excellent for cut-f lower displays. *Paeonia lactiflora*

Form	Perennial	Spread	32 - 36 inches
Hardiness Zone	3-8	Planting Instructions	Dig a hole large enough to spread out roots without bending them. Set crown with buds 1" below ground-level. Water in thoroughly. Plant at least 6 weeks before ground freezes.
Flowering Time	Midseason (Mid to late spring)	Soil Requirements	Well-drained, deep, fertile soil
Light Requirements	Full Sun, Partial Shade	Will Tolerate	Acidic Soil, Clay Soil, Loamy Soil, Sandy Soil
Flower Color	Deep ruby red.	Pruning	Remove spent flower stems after flowering to maintain an attractive bush type perennial all summer long.
Flower Form	Double, 6.5" flowers
