Features

A fascinating hybrid berry bush originally bred by plant researchers in Germany. The Jostaberry is a cross between three species; the black current (*R. nigrum*), the North American black gooseberry (*R. divaricatum*) and the European gooseberry (*R. uva-crispa*). The result is a vigorous, disease-resistant, thornless shrub that produces deep red-black, round berries. The sweet berries taste a bit like black currents and are ready for harvesting in mid-summer.

Best grouped or massed in a shrub border. Delicious in pies, tarts, jams, and preserves.
