#### Welcome to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Schedule

The Club managed to make it through a very cold, rainy April. We had quite a few ride cancellations, but our weather outlook is definitely looking brighter for the second schedule. For the first two rides, the Lites and Regulars will have the same starting point. All of the rides on the 2<sup>nd</sup> schedule will start at 9:00, except for the Regular's Hastings Ride which begins at 10:00.

#### Club News

Lite Riders will continue to ride on Wednesdays, only, while the Regulars will still have the option to ride on Monday and/or Wednesday. The Monday ride is actually a Pre Ride and will be a bit faster. It will also be more exploratory checking for trail closures and alternate routes. It will have the same start time and location as the Wednesday ride. Note the Cancellation Info Line will available for both the Monday and Wednesday rides.

The Regulars will be doing a Hastings Ride on June 15th starting at 10:00. It's a very scenic ride with Mississippi River views beginning at Spring Lake Park, and going all the way to Hastings. On the return trip, we will ride along the Vermillion River, and see the beautiful Vermillion Waterfalls. We highly recommend this ride led by Kevin Krueger! There will be no Pre Ride for the Hastings Ride.

We are in the process of creating a club directory for use in sending group emails and for individuals to contact one another. We already have many email addresses from previous years, but addresses for newer members have not been provided by Park & Rec. During the weekly sigh-in process someone may ask for you for yours. Please provide your email address if you want to be included in the club directory.
