T-BALL RULES

1. NO score is kept. We are promoting learning how to play without being concerned about a winner and a loser.
2. No more than 10 players in the field at a time – no team should have over 10 players. Teams use an unlimited batting order – all players bat. No more than five infielders, not including pitcher (no catcher needed). We will try to have the children experience playing a variety of different defensive positions during the season.
3. No strike outs. Every child will be allowed to swing until they hit a fair ball. In T-ball, a 10 foot radius in front of home plate is considered foul territory.
4. Each team will bat until all players have batted. Last batter runs all bases, unless tagged out. ****use throw down bases for this level.**
5. Please stress to the kids to drop bat before running and not throwing the bat.
6. For the batting team, all players must remain on the bench until it is their turn to bat.
7. Maximum of 1 base at a time.
8. Games will last one hour once started.
9. Teams will wave or tip hat at after each game (no handshakes).
10. **Only the batter at the plate is allowed to have a bat in their hands.**
