All rides start at 9:00 a.m.

May 22- 9:00Fish Lake, Rice Lake LoopLeader: Deb Grill (763) 593-5381Meet in the parking lot at Fish Lake Regional Park, 14900 Bass Lake Road.We will ride up the eastsides of both Fish & Rice Lake. Then continuing the loop anticlockwise back down west of the lakes and
including a long downhill joy ride re-entering the park. Paved with a few moderate hills. Distance: 13.5 miles.(Start Location)

May 29- 9:00 (New) Sculpture Ride & Powderhorn Park Leader: Bill Lundberg 651-235-3701

Meet by the triangle park at Drew Ave. So. & Cedar Shore Dr. near Cedar Lake. 3501 W 24th St. Mpls. Ride to view "The Giraffe" sculpture, "The Pencil", a large shark sculpture and a dinosaur along the way. We'll ride on the brand new Bryant Ave. Bike Trail, over to the Rose Gardens. There will be a coffee stop. Approx 20 mi., mostly bike trails and fairly level. (Start Location)

Meet at the Luce Line trailhead off Vicksburg Lane. We ride the Luce Line to Noerenberg Gardens. Gently rolling hills on route. Approx. 13 miles. (Start Location)

We will ride the new Nine Mile CreekTrail and some side streets to Edina and return along the same route. The trail is mainly flat with a fewmoderate hills leading to a number of long bridges. There will be a coffee stop. About 16 miles.(Start Location)

June 19 -9:00Wirth-Victory Pkwys/N Miss ParkLeader: Norm Spaeth (763) 458-2431Meet at the parking lot in the Lakeview Terrace Park in Robbinisdale.We will travel via Wirth, VictoryMemorial, and Webber Pkwys. to Webber Park and then by W. River trail to N. Miss. Park; then return via 47thAve., Shingle Creek and the Pkwys. Trail: Paved, about 12 miles. (Start Location)

Easy and flat paved trail.(Start Location)

Ride from Cedar Lake to the Greenway, then head south along the Mississippi River to Minnehaha Falls.Return along the creek trail to Lake Harriet, where we'll stop for a snack. Continue by way of Lake Calhounback to Cedar Lake. About 20 miles of paved trails and quiet city streets. Trail: Mostly level. (Start Location)
