## **General Information**

### **Club Groups**

Lite Riders will ride on Wednesdays only. The Regular Group riders will have the option to ride on Monday and/or Wednesday. The Monday ride may be more exploratory, checking for trail closures and alternate routes. The Monday ride will have the same start time and location as the Wednesday ride. Note that the "Ride Cancellation Info Line" will be available for Monday and both Wednesday rides.

#### **Ride Cancellation Info Line**

Our announcement line is 763-509-5275. On ride days, the announcement will be updated by 7:30 a.m. only if the ride is cancelled. Call the info line if in doubt about the weather so you don't drive to a ride and find out it was cancelled.

#### **Start Times**

All rides on the 3<sup>rd</sup> schedules start at 9:00, except 10:00 for both the Lites and the Regulars on July 10 and 10:00 for the Lites only on July 31.
