Kwanzan Cherry | *Prunus serrulata* 'Kwanzan'



Plant description

The pendulous, deep pink flowers make this one of the showiest cherries in spring. Foliage emerges coppery bronze, matures green, then turns reddish-copper in fall. This is one of the varieties used in the world famous Washington, D.C. cherry blossom display. Own root.

Height: 20-25'

Spread: 15-20'

Shape: Upright, becoming rounded with age

Exposure: Full Sun

Zone: 5-9
