As the subject of a children's service worker background check, you have the right to:

- be informed that the city will request this check for becoming or continuing as an employee or volunteer
- be informed of the results of the background check and to get a copy of the background check report
- obtain a copy of any record that forms the basis for the report
- challenge the accuracy and completeness of any information contained in the report
- be informed if the city has denies your application or continuation of employment or continuation of volunteering because of the results of the check
- not be required to pay the cost of the background check.

The Data Practices Act requires that we inform you that you do not need to provide this information; however, if the information is not provided, the city will no longer consider your application. Any omission or false representation by you will result in rejection of your application or if hired or enlisted as a volunteer, the termination of your employment or volunteer duties. I authorize the City of Plymouth Human Resources Department to disclose criminal history record information to the Plymouth Parks and Recreation Department for the purpose of employment as a (list position) _____ with this agency. The expiration of this authorization shall occur one year from the date of my signature. *(If you are under 18, you must have a parent/guardian sign for you.)*
