Payment options

1. Full Payment – Total of «Assessment»

- Principal amount will be assessed to your Hennepin County property tax equally over the terms of the assessment and will include interest of 4.56%. Interest will accrue from November 1, 2025, until December 31, 2026, and each year thereafter.
- The full, unpaid remaining balance can be paid to the City of Plymouth at any time.
- This option will be automatically selected if no payment is received by 4:30pm on October 31, 2025.

3. Partial Payment - Total amount owed varies

- Prepay any amount to the City of Plymouth no later than 4:30 pm on October 31, 2025.
- Partial payment reduces the amount of interest paid.
- The remaining balance follows the terms outlined above in option 2 as annual installments to property tax.
