If you are new to shopping farmers markets, here are some quick tips:

Go Early, for the best selection get to the market early. The best goods go first. Popular, but limited items may even sell out before the day is done.

Bring Big Bags and small change,

hardy canvas bags are best to carry your bounty and small change helps for quick and easy transactions.

Bring Cash, vendors do not accept credit cards or checks. For your convenience there is an ATM located in the Ice Arena (across from the Farmers Market location)

Get Advice, if you find a vegetable that is new to you ask the farmer how to prepare it. Most vendors are willing to sell smaller amounts, if asked.

Know your Seasons! Remember produce is seasonal. Not everything is in season all at the same time.
