- **Fire visits will be determined by a drawing that will be held at the July 25, 7-8 p.m. NTU Coordinator's meeting at the Plymouth Creek Center. Neighborhoods that had a visit in 2012 are not eligible for the drawing. A representative from the neighborhood must be present at the Coordinator's meeting to be eligible for a fire visit.**

Police and Fire have resources to visit 100 parties on NTU. Last year 133 block parties were registered. Police visits will be assigned based upon the order in which the registration forms were received.
